

REVIEW OF MANUSCRIPTS

Manuscript, submitted for publication in the journal, is held in the reviewing process for the purpose of expert judgment.

Reviewing of the manuscripts is done by members of the Editorial board and external reviewers who have closest to the topic scientific specialization and are recognized expert on the subject of peer-reviewed materials, and have in the last 2 years the publication on the subject of peer-reviewed articles.

Chief editor attracts external reviewers (Ph.D, including practitioners) who are not members of the Editorial board.

Chief editor agrees with the reviewer the deadline for submission of the review to the journal.

Time for consideration may not exceed one month (31 days).

The reviewer can not be the author or co-author of the peer-reviewed manuscript and scientific director of the author and a member of the department in which the author works.

If the Editorial board is not able to attract the proper level of review by specialist in the area of knowledge in which the content of manuscript is connected Editorial Board is drawn to the author with a proposal to submit external review.

Reviewer at the direction of the manuscript for review is notified that this manuscript is the intellectual property of authors and refers to information which is not subject to disclosure.

Reviewers are prohibited:

- To use the manuscript for their needs and the needs of third parties;
- To disclose the information contained in the manuscript before its publication;
- Transmit the manuscript for review to another person

without the consent of the chief editor;

- To use the material contained in the manuscript before it is published in its own interests.

Communication of the authors and reviewers carried out through the Editor.
